Tour Itinerary: 8 Days

1-2 FLY TO EUROPE. Board an overnight flight to Germany. Arrive in Munich and begin exploring.

3 MUNICH. A local guide shows you the highlights of the city, including the Frauenkirche, the Glockenspiel, and the 1972 Olympic stadium. Scour the city in **Schnitzel Jagd**.

4 SALZBURG. Visit Salzburg; take a walk along the Salzach River as you tour the birthplace of Mozart. The alpine scenery and exquisite churches created the perfect setting for *The Sound of Music*. Marvel at the Hohensalzburg fortress and the breathtaking arched roof of the Dom.

5 NYMPHENBURG PALACE. Visit the former concentration camp at Dachau. Later, marvel at Nymphenburg Palace. Its 500 acres are lined with French trimmed hedges and boast three pavilions and a miniature palace.

6 NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE. Enjoy an optional excursion to fairytale Neuschwanstein Castle, built for mad Bavarian King Ludwig II. A lesson in extravagance, with almost every inch covered in gilt, stucco, woodcarvings, and marble mosaics, the castle served as a model for Walt Disney's theme park. A visit to nearby Linderhof is also included. This afternoon, **Kulturkampf**.

7 ALTE PINAKOTHEK-NEUE PINAKOTHEK. View famous works of art as you explore the galleries of the Alte Pinakothek and Neue Pinakothek. The Alte Pinakothek is one of the oldest galleries in the world. The Neue Pinakothek features more recent artworks, dating back to the 19th century. Later, **Bask in Bavarian Arts**.

8 RETURN JOURNEY TO THE UNITED STATES.
